



ULTIMATE HOMESCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

BASIC SUPPLIES

- Notebooks and Loose-Leaf Paper: Wide-ruled or college-ruled, depending on the age of your children.
- Pencils and Erasers: Plenty of #2 pencils and good quality erasers.
- Pens: Blue, black, and red pens for writing and editing.
- Colored Pencils, Crayons, and Markers: For art projects, diagrams, and color-coded notes.
- Highlighters: In various colors for highlighting important information.
- Rulers: Standard 12-inch and metric rulers.
- Scissors: Child-safe scissors for younger children, regular scissors for older kids.
