BASIC SUPPLIES

	Notebooks and Loose-Leaf Paper: Wide-ruled or college-ruled, depending on the age of your children.
	Pencils and Erasers: Plenty of #2 pencils and good quality erasers. Pens: Blue, black, and red pens for writing and editing.
	Colored Pencils, Crayons, and Markers: For art projects, diagrams, and color-coded notes. Highlighters: In various colors for highlighting important information. Rulers: Standard 12-inch and metric rulers.
	Scissors: Child-safe scissors for younger children, regular scissors for older kids. Glue Sticks and Liquid Glue: For crafts, projects, and worksheets. Pencil Sharpeners: Both manual and electric, to keep pencils ready to use.
	Stapler and Staples: For organizing papers and creating booklets. Hole Punch: A 3-hole punch for organizing papers in binders. Tape: Clear, masking, and double-sided tape for various uses.
